The list below outlines the things current RVPs & SVPs completed while in the Base Shop prior to taking the RVP contract. Those that do typically went on to promote RVPs & build a Hierarchy

Full Time in Primerica – No Other Source of Income (NOSOI)		
Personal Premium Production Track Record (\$2,500 to \$5,000 per month = 3 to 7 cases per month)		
Team Premium (\$30K Base Shop - 100 codes = 20 producing codes generates \$30K - \$50 Base Shop)		
Personal IBA Production Track Record (2 -5 per month)		
Personal Securities Producer (Understand your AUM potential)		
Multiple Field Trainers (4 – 5 people, they were:) ☐ Full Time ☐ Couples Fully Licensed		
Multiple Full-timers (4 − 5) □ Every Full-Time Leg producing \$5 - \$10K Premium + 5 IBAs + Securities Production		
Multiple (7-10) Base Shop Trainees with activity at any one month		
Meeting Attendance – Never Missed & Team never missed – 40+ people at Opportunity Meetings		
Big Event Attendance – Never Missed & Team never missed		
Fully Licensed – Life, Securities & Other lines of Business		
Excellent Presentation Skills – Able to do Opportunity Meeting Presentations		
Replacement Leg = Striving to RVP, Field Training a Team doing \$10K premium+ or (2 Legs @ \$5K each)		
Team Cohesion • Team activities i.e.; potlucks, dream selling activities, new home tours, dream cars, etc.		
Constant communication with Up-line Leader.		
"Squeaky Wheeler" – Always open & looking for advice from Up-lines		
Patiently Intense - "Sense of Urgency"		
Emotionally mature – Did not create or get involved with minor "drama"		
Good Character - Integrity, Honest, Loyal – Willing to take the "High Road"		
Support System in place for children; nanny, grandparents, etc.;
